The cost for booth is one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.). Please include a **certified cheque** or **money order** with your application. We also accept credit cards: Visa and MasterCard.

Product Vendor Expectations and Guidelines

Arts & Crafts Vendor booth displays shall be confined to a space 10 ft. wide by 10 ft. deep. We do not supply tables or chairs for vendors. **Arts & Crafts should be 50% of Aboriginal handmade crafts.**

Absolutely **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS** are allowed in the festival area, nor is any person who is under the influence of either. **NO ELECTRICITY** is provided. If you plan to bring a generator, you must indicate that you will do so on your application. Generators may be used between the hours of 7am and 11pm daily. Access to portable water is not available. Vendors are responsible for staffing; set-up and tear down for their own booths/tables.

Each vendor will be responsible for providing all equipment required for its venue.

It is agreed that each vendor will haul away all empty cartons, boxes and other rubbish from their area at the end of each day and make sure that their area is left in good clean condition at the end of the Pow Wow.

Vendors are responsible for the security of their own goods.

Set-up Information

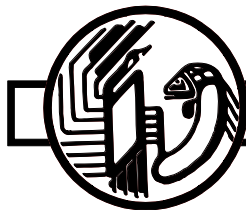
Set-up time is Friday 5:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. and Saturday from 7:00 a.m.-9:00 a.m. Vehicles will not be allowed on the festival grounds at any other times.

Vendors will be required to bring their own staff and volunteers to load-in and set-up your booth.

Take-down Information

Take down may begin at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. Vendors are asked to stay until the close of the event to ensure the safety of all in attendance. Your vehicles will be directed by our staff in order to facilitate leaving in a convenient and orderly fashion.
